Re: Freedom of Information Request

I refer to your current request for access under the *Freedom of Information Act 1982* (the FOI Act) to:

Any and all correspondence between the Minister of Foreign Affairs The Hon Julie Bishop and the Prime Minister The Hon Anthony Abbott, regarding Malaysia Airlines Flight 17.

Preliminary searches for documents relevant to your request have been completed. The next step is to consider the application of section 29 of the FOI Act, which concerns the charge, if any, for processing your request.

I am authorised under section 23 of the FOI Act to make decisions on the charge for processing your request. I have decided that you are liable to pay a charge. Based searches through several files, the identification of six relevant pages and time taken by the Decision Maker to assess your request (noting that the first five hours are free of charge), our preliminary assessment of the amount of that charge is \$46.00. Please note that at this stage in the FOI process, no decision has been made as to whether the information you seek will be released or exempt under the provisions of the FOI Act. It is quite likely given the nature of the documents that a decision will be made to redact them in full under exemptions available under the FOI Act. My decision relates only to the processing charges.

Now that we have given you written notice of our preliminary assessment of the amount of the charge for processing your request, section 29 provides that you have 30 days within which to:

- agree to pay the charge;
- contend that the charge has been wrongly assessed, or should be reduced or not imposed; or
- withdraw your request.

You can make your payment by cheque or money order made payable to 'The National Cashier – DFAT'; by credit card (an authorisation form to arrange payment of the application fee by Visa/Mastercard) is attached; or by Direct Debit – details below.

Should you contend that the charge has been wrongly assessed, or should be reduced or not imposed, you will now need to apply for the Department to waive or reduce the charge. A departmental decision-maker will then make a decision on whether the charge should be imposed, and in what amount. The decision will take account of any contentions you may make. The Department may waive or reduce the charge for any reason, including where:

- the payment of the fee or a part of the fee would cause you financial hardship; or
- the giving of access to documents relevant to your request is in the general public interest or in the interest of a substantial section of the public.

Please note that the onus to demonstrate that charges should be reduced or waived on these or other grounds is on you as the applicant.

Section 31 of the FOI Act provides that the 30 day period within which we should process your request is suspended until we receive your payment of the deposit for the charge for processing your request, or we decide not to impose a charge. Should you withdraw your request at this stage, no charge will be imposed.

If we do not receive your response to this letter within 30 days of its receipt, I will consider that you no longer wish to continue with your request, and I will deem it withdrawn.
