**FOI REQUEST: EXTENSION OF TIME FRAME  
DUE TO THIRD PARTY CONSULTATION**

I refer to your request of 20 February 2015 for access under *Freedom of Information Act 1982* (FOI Act) to:

*'Findings of Hepatitis A in the product 'Nanna's Frozen Berries' - first documentation revealing the outbreak; the recall documentation that was sent for the products; any legal documentation regarding the berries and patrons whom have caught Hepatitis A from these products'*

It appears to me, from the documents to which you seek access an Australian State may reasonably wish to make a contention concerning possible exemption of some or the entire document. I have, accordingly, determined that the requirements of section 26A make it appropriate to extend the time frame for dealing with your request.

I am writing to inform you, for the purposes of subsection 15(6) of the FOI Act, that the 30 day period for providing you with a decision has been extended by a further 30 days.
